

# Artist in Residence

Kru Moss was our artist in residence and worked with Key Stage 2 on a water colour project over a four week period. The children in Key Stage 2 have had extensive experience working with a variety of paint; block paint, household paint, acrylic, poster paint and powder paint and this was their first introduction to water colour.



Kru Moss introduced the technique called "painting wet on wet" where the children had to soak the painting paper in water before applying paint onto the wet paper. The children were fascinated to observe the way the colours dispersed and mixed together. At the beginning Kru Moss guided the children through structured painting sessions in order to develop basic skills in water colour painting.



The children truly enjoyed their experience and learnt a great deal about water colour; they look forward to more opportunities to explore and work using the wet on wet technique.
