Please note the following important information:

- Staff supervision in the playground begins at 8:10; parents or carers are requested to supervise in the playground before this time.
- Between 8:10-8:25, EY1&2 may go straight to their classrooms and participate in choosing activities.
- Our 'Move It' programme starts at 8:15, it is voluntary for EY1, 2&3 and highly recommended for children from EY4-Y6. Parents & carers are also welcomed to participate.
- 9:00-10:00, EY1-4 enjoy a self-service snack during the early years integrated programme.
- There are 3 lunch sittings: EY1-3 10:55-11:30, EY4-Year 1 11:30-11:55, Y2-6 12:10-12:30. Times are approximate.
- A light afternoon tea is available for EYFS and KS1 from 2pm and is optional for KS2. Additional snacks may be purchased after school in the tuck shop between 2:30 and 4:00pm.
- End of day pick up time is 2:30pm and children are supervised outside for 15 minutes. Duty staff gathers children who have not been collected at 2:45 and parents are contacted. Parents or carers supervise their children in the playground from 2:45 onwards.
